### Counselor's Corner

Happy November Beechwood Families. How is it November already?!?!

Last month I shared about our new social-emotional learning program- Open Parachute. I am really enjoying learning along with your children as we explore this new program. While each grade will cover different topics as the year goes on, all classes first receive an introduction to "mental health" and agree on ways to show respect for each other. Here is a glimpse into how mental health is introduced in our first Open Parachute lesson:

"Mental Health is how our thoughts and feelings change, depending on what we go through (for example, feeling happy or frustrated when we win or lose)."

"When we go through hard things, we feel sad, angry, and scared. When we do things we like, we feel happy, joyful, and proud. All of these positive and negative experiences make up our mental health, and are a normal part of being human."

"It is very important that we talk about mental health because it helps to explain why we feel so many different things all the time. The more we talk about it, the more we can help ourselves and each other!"

Addressing mental health with the students has become an increasingly important topic. I am so glad to have this new tool to help the children develop these important life skills.

Open Parachute also has a parent component that you may be interested in. Use the link below to access the Parent Dashboard. There is an audio series focused on skill building as well as three different parent resource courses (childhood, preteen & teen). I'll be sure to check it out with you. With the holidays fast approaching, I wanted to reach out with a few reminders. November is a month when we have a few days at home to get those important appointments scheduled.

If your child is in **4th grade** and you received notice about submitting a recent physical: Either schedule an appointment with your primary care physician or send in the one you have at home.

If you received notification that your child needs a **vision appointment**: Please call an eye doctor to have an exam. This can not be done by your primary care physician. If you need help with a referral please contact my office.

It is important for children who have eyeglasses to wear them while they are at school. Myopia (where far objects are blurry) is a progressive disorder. If left untreated, myopia can lead to an increased risk of cataracts, glaucoma and retinal detachment. Please follow the 20/20/20 minute rule. Every 20 minutes look 20 feet away for 20 seconds. Please call me if your child needs support at school to wear their glasses.

Hearing screenings will occur throughout the year. You will only receive a letter if your child does not pass the screening.

Lastly, I have received a large donation of clothing from Cradle to Crayons. If your child is in need of any clothing items please let me know or have them stop by my office.

During this time of Thanksgiving, I am most thankful to have the opportunity to care for your students and work with all the Beechwood Knoll families. Please feel free to call me if you have any questions or concerns.
