

Nurse's Message

Once again, another school year is coming to a close. There are several important announcements and reminders that I would like to bring to your attention:

Please remember to pick up all student medications from the nurse's office, otherwise they will be discarded on the last day of school. Also, <u>Care Plans</u> and <u>Medication Forms</u> for next year are now available on line.

If your child needs medication next year, please bring the completed and signed paperwork on the first day of the new school year. Remember to sign the parent permission form, obtain a doctor's signature for all prescription medications, and fill in the dosage, frequency, and symptoms for administration. All medication must be brought to school in the original container by a parent or guardian.

If your child has a special diet or health concern please list these on the emergency cards so that a health care plan can be created for the new school year and appropriate staff can be informed. Should you have any questions, feel free to contact me by calling or by email.
