Spring and Covid

With the warm weather coming, we are excited about the fresh air, increased opportunities to exercise and Vitamin D! For those who suffer from seasonal allergies, however, we are anticipating some challenges trying to figure out what is a seasonal allergy symptom vs. a suspect Covid symptom and we ask that families bear with us. If your child's symptoms fall in the overlapping section of the below CDC diagram, then please work with your school nurse to come up with a plan that limits absences, avoids unecessary doctor trips/testing, and helps manage symptoms.

- Have your pediatrician or allergist provide a note to the school nurse to document that your child has specific allergies
- Follow your doctor's management plan whether that includes over the counter allergy medications, avoiding certain exposures, or starting prescription medications (i.e. inhalers for cough)
