Another school year is coming to a close. I hope you have seen so much growth in your child this year.



Protocol for Visitors entering the Quincy Public Schools

- 1. Please use the intercom buzzer to communicate with office staff.
- 2. State your name and your purpose for being at the school.
- 3. Remove hats, hood, sunglasses etc.
- If office staff cannot see you, you will be asked to look into the camera to be identified.
- Please have an ID (Identification ready to be shown to school personnel when you enter the school, driver's license/picture ID etc.)
- Report immediately to the school office to sign in.
- 7. Once you are signed into the school you will be given a Visitor ID badge on a red lanyard. Please make sure that the date, time and who you are here to see is written on the sign in log. The visitor badge must be visible at all times.
- When leaving the school you will also need to sign out at the schools office and return your visitors ID badge with red lanyard.
- Failure to abide by any of the above requests will result in denied admittance into the school and you will be ordered to leave the school property immediately.

Dismissal Note: Friendly reminder that all families are expected to stay on the driveway or grass. The sidewalk along the school is for <u>students only.</u>
