President's Report: Given by Co-President Kristin Campbell (KC) and Katie Sampson (KS)

- Penguin Pizza, Pizza Kit fundraiser this week. Place orders by Wednesday, May 10th.
- Last day of school is 6/20/2023.
- Discussed a Paint Night at last meeting, but learned that this would be expensive. Somewhere in the area of \$30/participant. Could cost the PTO around \$4,000. Rather than this event, an alternative suggestion was a Movie Night w/hoodsie cups/freeze pops, popcorn. Suggesting this for the end of the school year. Due to sunsetting later in June, Movie Night idea scrapped and instead Ice Cream Social w/outdoor games was proposed. Proposing Friday, June 2nd from 6-7pm for Lawn Games and Hoodsie Cups and Freezer Pops.
