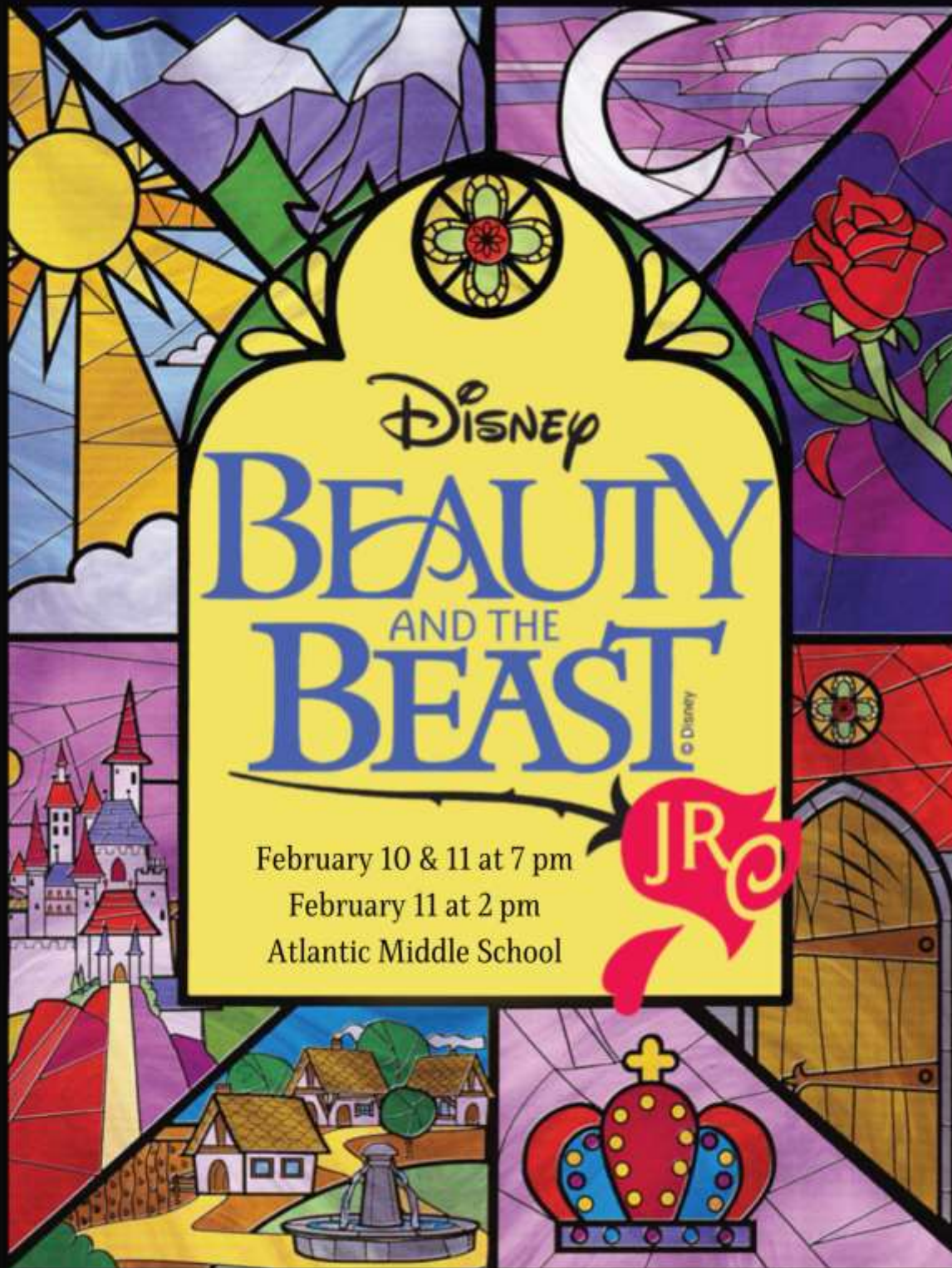

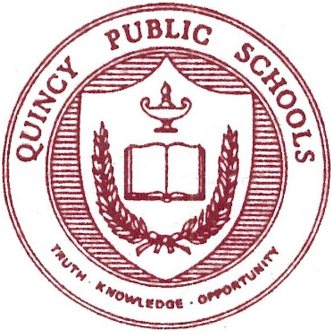

Adults

Adults – Watercolor All Levels – January 9th – February 27th

This class will include observational drawing and understanding color. The emphasis will be on individual interests and guiding individuals in their development of personal expression. We will explore a variety of techniques. All levels are welcome to develop painting skills and concepts. A discussion of materials and styles will be included.
