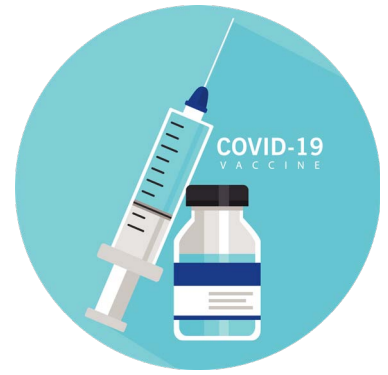

*Saturday, October 9th, 11am- 2pm @ Passaganesset Park – Located next to the Quincy Youth Hockey Area

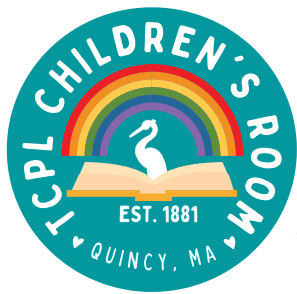
