Dear Quincy Public Schools Parents, Guardians, and Staff,

Planning and preparation for the 2021-2022 school year is continuing here at the Coddington Building and all of our school locations. The Massachusetts Departments of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) and Public Health are continuing to release updated guidance to be implemented for the new school year. At the School Committee meeting held this past Wednesday, the policy requiring face coverings for students, staff, and visitors in school buildings was reviewed and will remain in place for the beginning of the school year. We are continuing to monitor the guidance and will update safety protocols and share additional new information as it becomes available.

We look forward to meeting with you next week and welcoming everyone back for the new school year on September 8 (Grades 1-9), September 9 (Grades 10-12), and September 13 (Pre-Kindergarten & Kindergarten).






