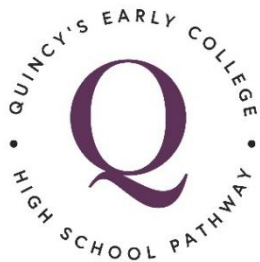

ENG 111: Public Speaking (3 Credits)

9:00 AM – 1:00 PM

Students will develop self-confidence and skills in oral communication. Each student will have the opportunity to participate in a number of speech situations, including impromptu speeches, panel discussions, and evaluative listening.

CSI 101: Introduction to Computers (3 Credits)

This course introduces students to the theory, structure, and application of computers. Topics include word processing, spreadsheet organization, presentations, and database management.

BUS 101: Foundations of Business (3 Credits)

9:00 AM – 1:00 PM

The role, growth, structure, and functional organization of modern business in the U.S. economy is explored. Opportunities in the business field are examined throughout the course. Students will be expected to complete outside research as a course requirement.

SOC 101: General Sociology (3 Credits)

9:00 AM – 1:00 PM

An examination of the behavior of humans in social groups. Emphasis will be placed on concepts in micro and macro sociology, including culture, social roles, institutions (family, education, health care, religion, economy and politics), inequality, social change, and demographics.

MAT 113: Pre-Calculus (3 Credits)

9:00 AM – 1:00 PM

This course in pre-calculus mathematics includes topics in algebra, coordinate geometry, functions, exponents, logarithms, trigonometry and analytic geometry.

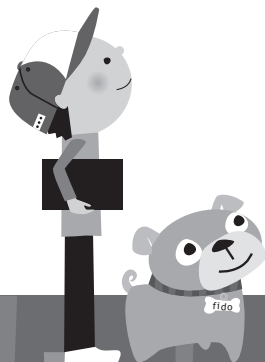

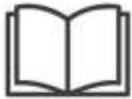
